Notice is hereby given that Delaware County, Ohio, has prepared a draft 2025–2029 Five-Year Consolidated Plan for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, as administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). In accordance with the citizen participation requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act and applicable federal regulations, Delaware County is providing the public an opportunity to review and comment on the draft Consolidated Plan.

The public comment period will begin **December 15, 2025**, and will conclude after 30 days on **January 14, 2026**. Written comments regarding the draft Consolidated Plan will be accepted throughout this period. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive public input on community development needs, proposed priorities, and the planned use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds over the five-year planning period. The hearing will include an overview of the Consolidated Plan, eligible CDBG activities, anticipated funding levels, and how CDBG resources are proposed to support housing, public infrastructure, public facilities, public services, and other community development activities that primarily benefit low- and moderate-income residents.
