

PUBLIC NOTICE SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY BY INTERNET AUCTION

By resolution No. 16-749 on August 1, 2016, The Board of Commissioners of Delaware County, Ohio has declared its intent to sell surplus property through the Internet auction conducted by GovDeals.com.

The auctions shall be conducted on a continuous basis and may be access on Delaware County's web site at <https://co.delaware.oh.us/> under the heading "Quick Links" and "GovDeals Auction" Items shall be posted for a period of no less than 10 days.

Each item is sold "as is" and "where is". Delaware County makes no warranties, whether expressed or implied, or representation regarding any surplus sold.

The highest bid for the surplus property will prevail. However, Delaware County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to withdraw from sale any of the items listed, or to extend the time period for bidding.
