PETITION

The undersigned, as owners of that certain 2.144 acre parcel of real property known as and located at 3238 Radnor Road, Radnor, Radnor Township, Delaware County, Ohio and described and depicted on the attached Exhibit A, hereby petition the Board of Commissioners of Delaware County. Ohio, as provided in Section 5553 of the Ohio Revised Code, to vacate the entire alley located between Lots 8 and 9, as depicted on the attached Exhibit B (the Alley").

The Alley was created by the filing of the Plat of the town of Radnor, which Plat was filed on March 15, 1876 in Plat Book 2, Page 262. Delaware County, Ohio Recorder's Office. A copy of the Plat is attached hereto as Exhibit C. The Alley has been abandoned and has not been used for a period of more than 21 years prior to the date of this Petition. 


