The Brown Township Trustees met on this date at 7:00 PM in regular form with Trustees Miley and Skinner, Fiscal Officer Peggy Link, Road Superintendent Dan Gladman and Zoning Inspector Susan Kuba

Trustee Skinner made a motion to approve the April 13, 2021 agenda as amended. Trustee Miley seconded. Motion passed.

Zoning Inspector Kuba led the Pledge of Allegiance

Trustee Skinner made a motion to approve the March 9, 2021 regular meeting minutes as presented. Trustee Miley seconded. Motion passed.

Fiscal Officer's Report:

Fiscal Officer Peggy Link reported that the First Commonwealth checking account balance is \$211,454.39 and earned \$2.49 in interest. Star Bank balance is \$1,336,614.94 and earned \$91.55 in interest. She passed around the reconciliation checklist and timesheet and EFT listing for review and approval for March 2021. Fiscal Officer Link gave a brief update on the direct deposit process for the township. She has received authorization from all employees authorizing direct deposit. Ms. Link shared she is still trying to figure out how she can include reimbursements into the direct deposit process.

Delaware County Engineer:

Mr. Reidel was not present. He will present cost estimates when Trustees meet with him later in the month for the road inspections. Trustee Miley indicated the township has not heard anything yet related to OPWC.

Ms. Edwards was not present.

Zoning Inspector Kuba gave a written report. There were a lot of zoning permits this past month.

Road Superintendent:

Road Superintendent Gladman shared his report. Mr. Gladman shared that Housekeeper Hedrick texted him to share there was a spot in the curb missing by the ballfield. Mr. Gladman shared the Grant and him were able to repair the big truck. Mr. Gladman shared that the glow plugs for the Ford F350 would cost \$180 for parts and \$480 to install. Trustee Miley made a motion to approve a cost of up to \$750 to have Byers Ford replace the glow plugs on the F350 truck. Trustee Skinner seconded. Motion passed.

Roads

Trustee Miley noted that the culvert of Veley was being replaced with a 60' instead of 40'. Discussion occurred on retaining the guardrail that was being taken down. Cemetery

Cemetery Sexton Harp was absent. Trustee Skinner shared that there has been issues finding the clay markers and Cemetery Sexton Harp and her would like to explore replacing with metal markers. Trustee Skinner is planning to submit a grant to provide funds with fixing foundations and potentially purchasing the metal markers. The new mower has not arrived yet and the delay is likely due to the pandemic. Trustee Skinner shared that she is working to arrange a meeting with Fiscal Officer and Cemetery Sexton to get more clarity around the foundation order process.

Fire Department:

Trustee Miley gave a few updates. The appraisal is coming soon. The Board is looking into financing with the Land Bank with a lower financing rate but shorter terms. The engine chassis is moving to South Dakota. COVID cases are dropping and there are no cases at the fire department. Sands and Deck will do the civil engineering at an approximate cost of \$24,060.

Old Business:

Trustee Miley is continuing to work on the TIF for SR521. He asked if there were other properties to consider.

Trustee Skinner shared that there is no update on the contract for the Board of Elections using the hall for elections. The parties are still waiting for Mr. Fowler to provide the

Trustee Miley gave a brief update on the Sheets property. Rory backed out. Mr. Sheets wants the property to be square which would require us to purchase more than 5 acres and would cost approximately \$18,000 more than we budgeted. Mr. Sheets shared with Trustee Miley he would accept a promissory note. Trustee Miley will reach out to Assistant Prosecutor Mr. Fowler to discuss the lien on the property as well as other considerations so the township can be prepared to move forward. Trustee Skinner shared that Mr. Sheets owns the property across from Hogback Road at SR 521 and Frontier will not do anything to maintain the line until the owners deal with the trees.

Fiscal Officer Link shared the updated position description and proposed advertisement for the replacement position for Grant Tobias. Discussion occurred about advertisement of the position will occur in Indeed.com as well as the way to accept applications. The cost to advertise in the Columbus Dispatch is significant and therefore we will advertise the position multiple times in the Delaware Gazette as well as post the position on the Township's Facebook page. We will plan to accept applications until May 31st. Fiscal Officer Link will make some final edits and send out to review before proceeding with the advertisement.

Delaware County Engineer:

Mr. Reidel was not present.

Delaware County Health Department:

Ms. Edwards was not present.

Delaware County Preservation Parks

Tom Curtin from Preservation Parks attended the meeting. He gave many updates. Park attendance was up 60% this past summer. They continue to acquire land. The latest was Bale Kenyon and Orange Road for 235 aces. They are renovating the barn on the property. The Park Board is pursuing a .4 mil levy to acquire 1200 acres of land. This would be \$3.7 million per year for 10 years (or \$37 million total). Hogback Ridge neighbors adjacent to the park want to sell land. Trustee Miley brought up concerns from the Mud Run at Gallant Park sharing that the trail narrows and with that comes the ability to address emergency issues with accessing the individuals. Mr. Miley also mentioned that there is concern with the canoe launch at the basin of Delaware Dam. The fire department has significant challenges with accessing any emergency situation. Folks bipass the gates even when locked. Mr. Miley suggested that they look at options such as signage and other ideas to address this. When the water level is at a dangerous level emergency crews would be challenged due to the launch availability for them.

Public Participation:

Susan Kuba shared that the Brown Bakers & Rakers 4-H club will be picking up trash at the ballfield as well as helping to put up flags at the cemetery for their service project.

Zoning Inspector:

Zoning Inspector Kuba passed out a written report which includes a summary of permits including the new ones. Ms. Kuba shared that she has been approached for more information regarding adult family homes (which is 3-5 adults non-related living in one home) or adult group home which is 6-16 adults non-related living in one home. She has reached out to Mr. Fowler to obtain advice. Ms. Kuba shared that she will be away on May 18th for a medical procedure and out of state for vacation from June 5th – June 13th.

Road Superintendent:

Road Superintendent Gladman shared his report. Mr. Gladman shared a quote from Parrott Implement to purchase weights for the new tractor. Trustee Skinner made a motion to approve the purchase of front weights for the tractor from Parrott Implement for \$1603.53. Trustee Stegner seconded. Motion passed.

Mr. Gladman discussed that this mower is not as wide and should he do 3 or 4 passes. Trustees agreed and discussed that keeping the side wheels on the berm in order to refrain from getting the tractor stuck. He has not yet scheduled the F350 for glow plug replacement. Mr. Dennison is scheduled for a doctor appointment in early June and hopes to be released to return to work.

Roads

The Veley Road culvert is done. Trustee Miley shared that he has not received any estimates on the REAs submitted yet. Mr. Miley mentioned he has been considering the CEA culvert issue. Suggesting that maybe cementing the bottom of the ditch instead of the headwall. Trustees discussed if this will cost more especially if they have to also do the concrete headwall. Trustee Miley will talk to Frank Cea to discuss further.

Cemetery

Cemetery Sexton Harp was absent. Trustee Skinner shared that Longstreth will attempt to pour tomorrow at 10 am. Ms. Skinner updated the bulletin board. Ms. Skinner is also wanting to update the internment. Discussion occurred around if we need this or refer to billion graves. Trustees discussed if it made sense to laminate the pages vs placing them in a binder cover. Ms. Skinner will investigate the cost of laminating. Trustees asked Mr. Gladman to have a quote for metal markers (numbered and unnumbered) for the next meeting.

Fire Department:

Trustee Miley gave updates. Mr. Miley shared the City could not come up with their share of the point project funds (\$8 million). Everyone is being encouraged to write to Troy Balderson to get money released. The project was originally slated to start in 2021 but now will not happen until 2022. Tri-township has borrowed \$3 million to get the station. County Commission Merrill was not happy about this. The Board will be meeting with Ed McCall (architect) at their next meeting. They will have several special meetings to manage the RFQ for the Civil Engineering. All the software update from the County is not compatible with Tri-Township. They will need to purchase pagers (\$500/piece). Tri-township is reinstating the Honor Guard. Mark Murphy will lead this initiative and they will purchase 4 jackets. Fiber optics will be available at the new station. 2 vehicles are being placed on gov.deal. Water rescue training will occur at the Delaware State Park. The Army Corp of Engineers purchased a new bought costing \$125,000 and Chief Morris received a set of keys. Touch a truck will occur on June 5th from 9-11. Chief Morris is teaching a high school public safety courses for 2-1/2 weeks.

Old Business:

Trustee Miley is continuing to work on the TIF for SR521.

Trustee Miley has not received any further updates. Could the board use the parks grant to assist with the land acquisition purchase which is due to be submitted June 18th. Trustee Skinner would need to know all the relevant costs such as survey, closing, purchase price, title search, etc.

Fiscal Officer Link shared the updated position description and proposed advertisement for the replacement position for Grant Tobias. Currently there are 7 applicants who all applied prior to any advertisements in the Delaware Gazette. Ms. Link will share a pdf file of the current applicants in order to keep Trustees apprised of if the search will need to last longer than May 31st.

Inventory updates still need to occur. Mr. Gladman and Ms. Link will work on updating the spreadsheets to present at the next meeting.

New Business:

Liquor permit notifications were received and Ms. Link was not 100% sure which one on the list applied. We believe these are existing permits being renewed. Trustees had no concerns.

Trustee Stegner shared several quotes to do maintenance around the new township hall. The first from Delaware Sealcoat was for \$7,227.70 to do crack seal, asphalt seal coat as well as striping. Trustee Miley made a motion to accept the quote for Delaware Sealcoat in the amount of \$7,227.70 for crack seal, asphalt seal coat and striping of the parking lot at 5555 State Route 521. Trustee Stegner seconded. Motion passed.

The county road improvement program has started. They will give notice of work as soon as it is known. They will be grader patching before chip seal. Mr. Riedel will have the estimate of berming roads for our next meeting. He will also present the OPWC work for signature at the next meeting. Culverts on Hogback Road will be done this year.

Ms. Harp is waiting for Bret Dennis to help her with setting up the new computer. Ms. Skinner and Harp have a meeting on Thursday to update Pontem and then Trustee Skinner will be able to print out the internment. Trustee Skinner gave an update on purchasing a laminator and supplies and for a small one the cost is approximately \$200 plus \$50 for 100 sheets. Mr. Frank Cea has offered to donate a large laminator and supplies and will confirm this. Mr. Gladman shared that he was aware of the half dead tree that needs to be removed.

Fire Department:
