IN THE MATTER OF DESIGNATING DELAWARE COUNTY REPRESENTATIVES AT MEETINGS TO BE HELD IN REGARD TO ONE OHIO REGION 18 GOVERNANCE:

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners (the "Board") adopted Resolution No. 18-130, declaring that the unlawful distribution of prescription opioids created a public nuisance in Delaware County, Ohio and has caused harm to the residents of Delaware County, Ohio, and authorized the retention of special counsel to commence civil litigation against opioid drug manufacturers and distributers; and

WHEREAS, the Board commenced civil litigation against opioid drug manufacturers and distributers; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution No. 20-257, approving the One Ohio Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU"), which provides an overall framework should a settlement be reached with opioid drug manufacturers and distributers; and

WHEREAS, the Board has approved Delaware County's participation in master settlement agreements that will be administered in accordance with the MOU; and

WHEREAS, the MOU provides for the creation of nineteen regions throughout the State of Ohio that will administer the portion of settlement funds allocated to and distributed from the statewide foundation, known as OneOhio Recovery Foundation, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the MOU requires each region to "create their own governance structure so it ensures all Local Governments have input and equitable representation regarding regional decisions," including representation on the statewide foundation board and the selection of projects for funding; and

WHEREAS, a meeting of representatives from political subdivisions of the seven counties within Region 18, of which Delaware County is a part, is scheduled for March 10, 2022, with the potential for additional meetings to create the Region 18 governance structure; and

WHEREAS, the Board is prepared to designate Delaware County representatives at the Region 18 meetings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Delaware County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Board hereby designates the following individuals as representatives of Delaware County at meetings to determine One Ohio Region 18 governance: Gary Merrell, County Commissioner; Bob Anderson, Director of Delaware County Department of Job and Family Services; and David Hejmanowski, Delaware County Juvenile/Probate Judge.

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 121.22(G)(8) of the Revised Code, a public body may hold an executive session to consider confidential information related to the marketing plans, specific business strategy, production techniques, trade secrets, or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance, or to negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting requests for economic development assistance, provided that both of the following conditions apply:

(1) The information is directly related to a request for economic development assistance that is to be provided or administered under any provision of Chapter 715., 725., 1724., or 1728. or sections 701.07, 3735.67 to 3735.70, 5709.40 to 5709.43, 5709.61 to 5709.69, 5709.73 to 5709.75, or 5709.77 to 5709.81 of the Revised Code, or that involves public infrastructure improvements or the extension of utility services that are directly related to an economic development project; and

(2) A unanimous quorum of the public body determines, by a roll call vote, that the executive session is necessary to protect the interests of the applicant or the possible investment or expenditure of public funds to be made in connection with the economic development project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Delaware County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Board hereby adjourns into executive session for consideration of appointment; employment of a public employee or public official to consider the purchase of property for public purposes; for pending or imminent litigation and confidential information related to economic development.

Section 2. The Board hereby adjourns into executive session to consider confidential information related to the marketing plans, specific business strategy, production techniques, trade secrets, or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance, or to negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting requests for economic development assistance.

Section 3. The Board hereby finds and determines that the information listed in Section 2 is directly related to a request for economic development assistance that is to be provided or administered under any provision of Chapter 715., 725., 1724., or 1728. or sections 701.07, 3735.67 to 3735.70, 5709.40 to 5709.43, 5709.61 to 5709.69, 5709.73 to 5709.75, or 5709.77 to 5709.81 of the Revised Code, or that involves public infrastructure improvements or the extension of utility services that are directly related to an economic development project.
