WHEREAS, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners (the "Board") is a party in Case No. 19-180-RR-UNC before the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO"), in the matter of the Joint Petition of Norfolk Southern Railway Company and CSX Transportation, Inc., to close the Franklin Street crossings in Orange Township, Delaware County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2023, PUCO issued an entry ordering the Board to, within thirty days, adopt a resolution discontinuing the use of the Franklin Street crossings and closing them to vehicles and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 4907.475 of the Revised Code, the discontinuance and closure as ordered shall be made by resolution as provided by sections 5553.01 to 5553.07 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2023, the Board adopted Resolution No. 23-256, declaring its opinion that it will be for the public convenience or welfare to vacate a section of Franklin Street in the unincorporated village of Lewis Center, Orange Township, Delaware County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2023, the Orange Township Board of Trustees filed with this Board a resolution of support (Orange Township Resolution 23-112), approving the vacation in accordance with section 5553.04(B) of the Revised Code; and


WHEREAS, the Board conducted a view of the proposed vacation on Monday, April 17, 2023, and held a final hearing on the proposed vacation on Thursday, April 20, 2023, all abutting landowners having been notified of the time, date, and location thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Engineer has provided a report regarding the proposed vacation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DELAWARE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The Board hereby finds and determines that the vacation of a section of Franklin Street, described as follows, would serve the public convenience and welfare:

That section of Franklin Street, fifty feet in width, between the western boundary of the right-of-way for the Norfolk Southern Railway Company rail lines and the eastern boundary of the right-of-way for the CSX Transportation (New York Central Lines) rail line, a distance of  $\pm 160$  feet, generally depicted as follows:



Section 2. The Board hereby declares the section of Franklin Street, as described in Section 1 of this Resolution, vacated, and such portion shall cease to be a public road. The section of Franklin Street vacated herein is entirely within the railroad right-of-way and shall remain railroad right-of-way.

Section 3. The Board hereby orders the discontinuation of the railroad crossings within the section of Franklin Street vacated herein and hereby orders that the railroad crossings are hereby closed to vehicular traffic and pedestrian traffic. These orders are made pursuant to section 4907.475 of the Revised Code and PUCO's order in Case No. 19-180-RR-UNC.

Section 4. The Clerk shall prepare a full record of the proceedings, including this Resolution, to be entered forthwith in the proper road records of the county by the Delaware County Engineer. The Board hereby directs the Clerk of the Board to also certify a copy of full record of the proceedings to the Delaware County Auditor and the Delaware County Recorder.

Section 5. The Board finds and determines that all formal actions taken by this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in said formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
