Trustee Skinner expressed that when there was an eclipse event at Henmick Brewery there was a big parking issue with people parking on the side of the road. This created a safety issue and trespassing situation.


Captain Vance was impressed with our foresight of Brown Township creating a "no parking" resolution, to help with traffic and parking issues. He suggested we ensure that the signs are not too far apart that they create a way for vehicles to park in between the signs. Any violations of the "no parking" zones would create an Ohio misdemeanor which would be a citation if they violate the "no parking" zone. Vehicles could be towed if they decide not to comply. The resolution would be forwarded to Delaware Municipal Prosecutor Amelia Bean-DeFlumer for further review. Brown Township might want to think about a "special event" resolution that has an ability to cover more events in the future.

Trustee Skinner made the motion approve a temporary "no parking" zone on Brown Township Road right-of-way's for public safety during the July 3rd fireworks event; under the Ohio Revised Code Section 505.17. Trustee Ebersole seconded. Motion approved.
