RESOLUTION NO. 2026-06-01-01

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY "NO PARKING" ZONE ON TOWNSHIP ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAYS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY DURING THE JULY 3RD FIREWORKS EVENT

The Board of Trustees of Brown Township, Delaware County, Ohio, met in Special session on the 1st day of June, 2026, at the Brown Township Hall with the following members present:

Trustee Skinner

Trustee Ebersole

Fiscal Officer Barrett

Trustee Skinner moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, a local brewery located within Brown Township is hosting public fireworks display on **July 3, 2026**; and

WHEREAS, this event is anticipated to attract a high volume of vehicular traffic and pedestrians, creating potential congestion and safety hazards on surrounding township roads; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.17 authorizes a Board of Township Trustees to make regulations necessary to control passenger car and commercial vehicle parking within the township; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it necessary to restrict parking within the township road rights-of-way near the event site to ensure unobstructed access for emergency medical services, fire departments, and law enforcement vehicles, thereby protecting the health, safety, and welfare of residents and visitors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Brown Township, Delaware County, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. A temporary "**NO PARKING**" zone is hereby established on both sides of the road right-of-ways for the following township roads:

- Leonardsburg Road from N. Old State to Giehl Rd
- Cackler Rd from Leonardsburg Rd to County Home Rd
- County Home Rd from Route 42 to State Route 521
- Bowtown Rd from N. Old State to Skinner Rd
- N. Old State from Bowtown Rd to Giehl Rd
- Mulberry from N. Old State to Main St
- Walnut St from N. Old State to Main St
- Pearl St from N. Old State to Main St
- White St from N. Old State to Main St.
- State Route 521 from County Home Rd. to Kilbourne Rd.

- Any adjacent township-maintained roads designated by law enforcement as critical safety corridors.

SECTION 2. This parking restriction shall be temporary and strictly enforced from [Start Time, 11:00 AM] on July 3, 2026, until [End Time, 11:59 PM] on July 3, 2026.

SECTION 3. The Brown Township [Road Superintendent / Fiscal Officer] is authorized and directed to procure and post temporary "No Parking" signs along the designated roadways at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the event, in accordance with standard traffic control guidelines.

SECTION 4. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 505.17, any vehicle parked in violation of this Resolution may be ordered towed and impounded at the owner's expense. Enforcement of this Resolution shall be carried out by the **Delaware County Sheriff's Office.**

SECTION 5. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
