RESOLUTION NO. 99-945

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING RESOLUTION DECLARING A DELAWARE COUNTY EOC-SOP DISASTER:

It was moved by Mrs. Martin and seconded by Mr. Ward to approve the following

WHEREAS, Delaware County, Ohio has been or is immediately threatened by a natural/man-made/technological hazard and or conventional attack, and:

Whereas, a state of emergency has been declared by the County Commissioners of Delaware County and/or the Governor of the State of Ohio and/or the President of the United States.

Now, therefore, we, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners or the Director of Emergency Management Agency, in their absence, declare those portions of the Ohio Revised code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance of this declaration, to be in full force and effect in the County for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for protection of the lives and property of the people of Delaware County and the restoration of local government with a minimum of interruption.

Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances and resolutions, particularly to Section 5915 of the Ohio Revised Code.

All public offices and employees of Delaware County are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives-state and local.

All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and emergency service forces in executing emergency operational plans, and to obey and comply with lawful directions of properly identified officers.

All operating forces will direct their communications and requests for assistance and operations directly to the Emergency Operations Center.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, Delaware County, that the declaration of the disaster for the Village of Ashley evacuation is canceled.
