### RESOLUTION NO. 05-1509

RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE SUFFICIENCY OF THE PEITTION FOR THE ES TABLISHMENT OF THE MILLSTONE COMMUNITY AUTHORITY AS A NEW COMMUNITY AUTHORITY AND SETTING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING UNDER CHAPTER 349 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE:

It was moved by Mr. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Ward to approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 349 of the Ohio Revised Code, a petition (the "Petition") providing for the establishment of The Millstone Community Authority (the "Authority") to govern a proposed new community district (the "District") was filed by the developer of the Authority (the "Developer") with this Board on October 25, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the "organizational board of commissioners," as that term is defined in Section 349.01(F) of the Ohio Revised Code, for the proposed Authority is comprised solely of the Board of County Commissioners of Delaware County; and

WHEREAS, the Petition was signed by the cities of Columbus, Ohio and Delaware, Ohio as the "proximate cities" pursuant to Chapter 349 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Petition further provided that the establishment of the Authority will be conducive to the public health, safety, convenience and welfare, and that such land to be included in the District is owned by, or under the control through leases of at least seventy-five years duration, options or contracts to purchase, of the Developer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 349.03(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, the Board has reviewed the Petition to determine whether the Petition complies with the requirements of Section 349.03 of the Ohio Revised Code as to form and substance; and

WHEREAS, the Board has further determined to fix a time and place of a public hearing on the Petition which public hearing shall be held not less than thirty (30) days nor more than forty-five (45) days from the date of the filing of the Petition and that notice of the public hearing shall be given by the Clerk of this Board, all as required by Section 349.03(A) of the Ohio Revised Code;

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

- 1. The Board finds and determines that the Petition complies with the requirements of Section 349.03 of the Ohio Revised Code as to form and substance.
- 2. A public hearing on the Petition shall be held on **Monday, December 5, 2005 at 7:30p.m.** at the offices of the Board, 101 North Sandusky Street, Delaware, Ohio.
- 3. The Clerk of this Board is directed to promptly give notice of the public hearing on the Petition by publication once each week for three consecutive weeks in *The Delaware Gazette*; provided that each such publication shall appear in *The Delaware Gazette* prior to the public hearing described in Section 2.
- 4. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of the Board concerning any of its committee's concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board and any of its committees that all deliberations of this Board and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
  - 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
