It was moved by Mr. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Evans to approve the following:

WHEREAS; on January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2006, a medical emergency occurred at Wendy’s Restaurant located at 1850 Columbus Pike Road; and

WHEREAS; the medical emergency consisted of a customer who was choking from a blocked airway; and

WHEREAS; Mr. Andrew Curran, without regard to reward or recognition, calmly assessed the situation and proceeded to apply his knowledge of the Heimlich process to clear the customer’s airway; and

WHEREAS; without the quick and decisive actions of Mr. Curran, the outcome of this emergency on the customer could have resulted in damaging trauma or even death; and

WHEREAS; upon arrival of the County EMS Medic Unit, the situation had been successfully resolved and no further treatment was needed;

THEREFORE be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Delaware County, State of Ohio, that Mr. Andrew Curran be recognized with this Citizenship Award for his quick and decisive actions that clearly demonstrates his care and concern for his fellow citizens and that averted a medical emergency that could have resulted in the possible loss of life.

WHEREAS; Mr. Blaettermann, with regard to reward or his personnel safety, reacted in a quick and decisive manner to pull the victim from the burning vehicle before the front passenger area becoming completely engulfed in flames; and

WHEREAS; arriving on scene four minutes after notification the County Medic found the front passenger area engulfed in flames and acknowledged that the patient would have received much more extensive injuries if not for the actions of Mr. Blaettermann;
