WHEREAS; the Delaware County Sewer District levies a surcharge for "above normal strength sewage" based on the following definitions:

- 1. "Normal sewage" means sewage which when analyzed shows by weight a daily average of not more than 250 parts per million of suspended solids, and not more than 200 parts per million of biochemical oxygen demand (BOD).
- 2. "Suspended solids" means solids that either floats on the surface of, or are in suspension in water, sewage, or other liquids and which are removable by laboratory filtering.
- 3. "CBOD" (denoting biochemical oxygen demand) means the quantity or oxygen utilized in the biochemical oxidation or organic matter, under standard laboratory procedure, in five (5) days at 20 degrees centigrade, expressed in parts per million by weight.

WHEREAS; The Commissioners Resolution No. 04-1601 requires all customers to be billed for their monthly service.

WHEREAS: The billing of customers also includes strength of sewage surcharge. The surcharge is determined by evaluating (sampling) the customer's strength of sewage.
