### Ditch Maintenance Petition- North Orange Section 1 Storm Sewer Improvement

We the undersigned owners of the remaining acreage within North Orange Section 1 in orange Township, Delaware County, Ohio propose to create a storm sewer extension as evidenced by the attached easement exhibit (Exhibit "A" which is available at the County Engineer's Office). The easement document for these North Orange Section 1 Storm Sewer Improvements have been submitted for approval to the Delaware County Engineer. The storm sewer extension has been constructed. (Exhibit "B" available at the County Engineer's Office). In accordance with Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code, we (I) hereby request that the improvements delineated on Exhibit "C" (available at the County Engineer's Office), be accepted as part of the County Drainage Maintenance Program and that an annual maintenance assessment be collected with the Real Estate Taxes for each lot in the subject subdivision to cover the cost of current and future maintenance of the improvements.

We (I) represent 100% of the property owners to be assessed for maintenance related to this drainage improvement. We (I) hereby waive our rights to a public viewing and hearing and ask that your board approve this action in conjunction with the approval of the North Orange Section 1 Storm Sewer Improvement easement documents.

The cost of the drainage improvements is \$34,360.90 and a detailed cost estimate as well as summary is available at the County Engineer's office in Exhibit "D". The drainage improvements are being constructed for the benefit of tributary commercial acreage created within this development. The developed commercial areas totaling 3.54 acres (the tributary area to this storm sewer extension) will receive benefit (cost) of the project on a per acre basis. The basis for calculating the assessment for each lot is therefore, \$9,706.47 per acre. An annual maintenance fee equal to 2% of this basis \$194.13/acre will be collected for each tributary lot with in North Orange Section One. I understand that the basis for calculating the maintenance assessment will be reviewed and possibly revised every 6 years. The first year's assessment for all of the lots in the amount of \$687.22 has been paid to Delaware County.

Easements to provide for the maintenance of the improvements have been provided on the plat.

### Ditch Maintenance Petition-Revised Petition For Olentangy Crossings Sections 1, 2, 3a, 7 And Lewis Center Road

We the undersigned owners of 170.553 acres in Orange Township, Delaware County, Ohio propose to create a subdivision known as Olentangy Crossings Section 1 (15.999 acres), Olentangy Crossings Section 2 (59.260 acres), Olentangy crossings section 7 (41.047 acres) and the existing Board of Education of Olentangy Local Schools (Olentangy High School and Shanahan Middle School) (54.247 acres) as evidenced by the attached subdivision plat (Exhibit "A" which is available at the County Engineer's Office) and future plat exhibit. This plat has been approved and signed by the Delaware County Regional Planning Commission and the Delaware County Engineer. Drainage improvements related to this subdivision have been constructed (or are bonded and will be constructed within a period of one year as evidenced by the Subdivider's agreement Exhibit "B" available at the County Engineer's Office). In accordance with Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code, we (I) hereby request that the improvements delineated on Exhibit "C" (available at the County Engineer's Office), be accepted as part of the County Drainage Maintenance Program and that an annual maintenance assessment be collected with the Real Estate Taxes for each lot in the subject subdivision to cover the cost of current and future maintenance of the improvements.

We (I) represent 100% of the property owners to be assessed for maintenance related to this drainage improvement. We (I) hereby waive our rights to a public viewing and hearing and ask that your board approve this action in conjunction with the approval of the **Olentangy Crossings Sections 1 plat.** 

The cost of the drainage improvements is \$585,521.40 and a detailed cost estimate is available at the County Engineer's office in Exhibit "D". The drainage improvements are being constructed for the benefit of the lots being created in this development. The Developed commercial, mulit-family and school areas totaling 83.76 acres will receive an equal share of the benefit (cost) of the project on a per acre basis. An annual maintenance fee equal to 2% of this basis will be collected for each tributary lot with in the Olentangy Crossings Section 2 (59.260 acres), Olentangy crossings section 7 (41.047 acres) Olentangy High School. The total annual drainage maintenance fee for this development is \$12,590.73. The Basis for calculating the assessment of each lot is shown on the summary spreadsheet (available at the County Engineer's Office).

I understand that the basis for calculating the maintenance assessment will be reviewed and possibly revised every 6 years. The first year's assessment for all of the lots in the amount of \$12,590.73 has been paid to Delaware County. (12,033.32 by planned communities and 557.41 by olentangy schools District).

Easements to provide for the maintenance of the improvements have been provided on the plat.

- I. Approve departmental payrolls for all departments under the Board of Commissioners
- II. In the absence of the County Administrator, the Director of Administrative Services or the Assistant to the County Administrator shall become acting County Administrator for the specific purpose of this resolution:
- III. Approve unpaid leaves of absence for up to 2 weeks
- IV. Negotiate, approve, and execute contracts and agreements and change orders under \$5,000 and for one (1) year or less (with advance notice to the Board of Commissioners)
- V. The County Administrator shall have the authority, and in the absence of the County Administrator, the Director of Administrative Services or the Assistant to the County Administrator shall have the authority to approve the specific purpose of this resolution:
  - 1. Workers compensation settlement agreements for amounts less than or equal to \$5,000 with notice to the Board of Commissioners in advance
  - 2. Property and liability claim settlement agreements for amounts less than or equal to \$5,000 with follow-up written notice within three business days to the Board of Commissioners
  - 3. Medical claim exceptions for amounts less than or equal to \$5,000 with follow-up written within three business days to the Board of Commissioners
  - 4. Merit, Educational, Certification, Probationary, Bargaining Agreement, Market Review wage increases or otherwise that have been approved indirectly by the Board of Commissioner resolution
  - 5. Mortgages Final Payment
