A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENTS TO CERTAIN DOCUMENTS RELATING TO THE COUNTY OF DELAWARE, OHIO ADJUSTABLE RATE DEMAND HEALTH CARE FACILITIES REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2007A (WILLOW BROOK CHRISTIAN COMMUNITIES PROJECT) OF THE COUNTY OF DELAWARE, OHIO, CURRENTLY OUTSTANDING IN A PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$21,830,000; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDED AND RESTATED INDENTURE AND AN AMENDED AND RESTATED SUBLEASE; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A TAX REGULATORY AGREEMENT AND RELATED CERTIFICATES; AND AUTHORIZING OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

It was moved by Mr. O'Brien, seconded by Mr. Stapleton to approve the following:

WHEREAS, the County of Delaware, Ohio (the "County"), a county and political subdivision in and of the State of Ohio (the "State"), is authorized and empowered by virtue of the laws of the State, including without limitation, Chapter 140 of the Ohio Revised Code (the "Act"), to, among other things: (i) acquire, construct, improve and equip "hospital facilities", as defined in the Act, which include the facilities comprising the Project (as herein defined), and to acquire by lease real estate within the boundaries of the County and interests

therein, including without limitation, improvements situated thereon comprising such hospital facilities; (ii) enter into a lease agreement to provide for the lease of "hospital facilities" to a "nonprofit hospital agency", both as defined in the Act; (iii) issue its revenue bonds for the purpose of financing the "costs of hospital facilities", as defined in the Act, and to secure those revenue bonds by a trust indenture and by the pledge and assignment of the rent paid under the lease agreement and the funds created under the trust indenture; (iv) enact this Resolution; and (v) enter into the Amended Indenture, the Amended Sublease and the Tax Regulatory Agreement, all as hereinafter defined, and to execute and deliver certain other documents and instruments upon the terms and conditions provided herein and therein; and

WHEREAS, the County has heretofore issued its Adjustable Rate Demand Health Care Facilities Revenue Bonds, Series 2007A (Willow Brook Christian Communities Project) (the "Series 2007A Bonds") on November 14, 2007 in the aggregate principal amount of \$21,830,000, which are currently outstanding in a principal amount of \$21,830,000;(the "Bonds"), pursuant to the Trust Indenture, dated as of November 1, 2007 (the "Indenture") between the County and U.S. Bank National Association, as trustee (the "Trustee"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement of Lease dated as of November 1, 2007 (the "Lease"), the Issuer acquired a leasehold interest in the Existing Facilities, affording health care and treatment for its residents, such hospital facilities including the structures, equipment and furnishings thereof and appurtenances thereto together with all real and personal property and interests therein used in connection therewith as then existing or as thereafter acquired, constructed, extended and improved, including the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Sublease dated as of November 1, 2007 (the "Sublease"), the County made the proceeds of the Bonds available to Willow Brook Christian Communities (the "Corporation") for the purpose of, together with other available moneys of the Corporation, (1) financing the acquisition, construction and equipping of certain Hospital Facilities, as that term is defined in Section 140.01, Ohio Revised Code, including, without limitation, the construction of 54 independent living apartments and 36 assisted living units to be located on the Corporation's facilities located at 100 Delaware Crossing West, Delaware, Ohio (the "Project"), including the reimbursement of the Corporation for costs previously incurred with respect to such Hospital Facilities, (2) refunding the outstanding principal amount of the Prior Bonds (as defined in the Indenture), (3) funding interest during construction of the Project, and (4) paying certain costs and expenses of the County and the Corporation incurred in connection with the issuance of the Series 2007 Bonds and the refunding and retirement of the Prior Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Sublease provides for the repayment by the Corporation of the proceeds of the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Project continues to be owned and operated by the Corporation, and

WHEREAS, to add an interest rate mode and to remove an interest rate mode by which the Bonds may bear interest, the County and the Trustee have agreed to enter into an Amended and Restated Trust Indenture (the "Amended Indenture") for the purpose of modifying certain terms and provisions of the Indenture and the Bonds (which will result in the reissuance of the Bonds), the County and the Corporation have agreed to enter into an Amended and Restated Sublease (the "Amended Sublease") for the purpose of modifying certain terms and provisions of the Sublease, and the County, the Corporation and the Trustee have agreed to enter into a Tax Regulatory Agreement (the "Tax Regulatory Agreement") for the purpose of and memorializing the reissuance of the Bonds and the documents executed and delivered in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Borrower has requested that the County approve this form of Resolution by its members in order to effectuate the terms and provisions of the Amended Sublease, Amended Indenture and the Tax Regulatory Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Delaware, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. Determination of County. In order to provide for the modification of certain terms and provisions of the Bonds and the documents pursuant to which such Bonds were issued, the County hereby determines it to be necessary to, and the County shall, execute and deliver, as provided herein, the Amended Sublease, the Amended Indenture, the Tax Regulatory Agreement, and such other documents or certificates as shall be necessary for the effectuation of the purposes thereof, upon the terms and conditions therein set forth and such action will comply with the purposes and provisions of the Act.

Section 2. Definitions. In addition to the words and terms defined in this Resolution, the words and terms used in this Resolution shall have the meanings set forth in the Amended Sublease and the Amended Indenture, unless the context or use indicates another or different meaning or intent, which Amended Sublease and the Amended Indenture and other documents and certificates referenced therein are before this meeting.

Section 3. Authorization of Amended Sublease, Amended Indenture, Tax Regulatory Agreement and all Documents to be Executed by the County. At least two members of this Board be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the County, the Amended Sublease, the Amended Indenture, the Tax Regulatory Agreement and the Bonds (Replacement Bonds), in substantially the form submitted to the

County, which are hereby approved in all respects with such changes therein as such officials, with the advice of counsel, may approve and determine, as conclusively evidenced by their execution thereof, to be advisable and in the best interests of the County and in conformance with this Resolution. The documents before this meeting, including the Amended Sublease, the Amended Indenture, the Tax Regulatory Agreement, and the Bonds (Replacement Bonds), have been approved in the forms submitted, and the Clerk of this Board is hereby directed to keep such documents on file.

Section 4. General. At least two members of this Board be and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the County, to execute any and all instruments, documents and certificates, perform any and all acts, approve any and all matters, and do any and all things deemed by them to be necessary or desirable in order to carry out the purposes of this Resolution (including the preambles hereto).

Section 5. Invalidity. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be ruled by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, clauses or provisions.

It is the purpose and intent of the Board that this resolution constitute approval of the Bonds for the purposes of Section 147(f) of the Code and the approval of the Project. The County does not bear any responsibility for the tax-exempt status of the Bonds, the debt service on the Bonds or any other matter related to the Bonds.

Section 8. Open Meetings Law. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the rules of this Board in accordance therewith.

Section 9. Conflicts. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 10. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
