WHEREAS, a permanent dog registration shall be charged a fee equal to ten times the annual dog registration fee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Delaware County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Board, having estimated that the fees established in this Resolution are needed to pay all expenses for the administration of Chapter 955 of the Revised Code and to pay claims allowed for animals injured or destroyed by dogs, hereby establishes the following dog registration and kennel fees for Delaware County:
