Re: Support of Online Voter Registration

Dear Secretary Husted,

On behalf of the Delaware County Board of Commissioners, we are writing in support of legislation that would give Ohioans the opportunity to register to vote online, because it is both more secure and cost effective.

As the government body tasked with the responsibility of the funding the Delaware County Board of Elections, we are supportive of all efforts to cut costs in a responsible manner. Data shows that an online voter registration system can save anywhere from 50 cents to \$2.34 per registration. Between 2011 and 2014, this could have amounted to a savings of anywhere between \$2.8 million and \$13.2 million for the state of Ohio. On a local level, this means Delaware County could have saved between \$35,235 and \$164,897 over this same time period.

Nationally, online voter registration legislation has been passed in twenty-eight states. Additionally, it has bipartisan support, would strengthen the security of Ohio's voter rolls and make the registration process easier for all Ohioans, including our servicemen and women.

We are happy to join you in urging favorable consideration of online voter registration in Ohio.

(2) A unanimous quorum of the public body determines, by a roll call vote, that the executive session is necessary to protect the interests of the applicant or the possible investment or expenditure of public funds to be made in connection with the economic development project;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Delaware County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Board hereby adjourns into executive session to consider confidential information related to the marketing plans, specific business strategy, production techniques, trade secrets, or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance, or to negotiations with other political subdivisions respecting requests for economic development assistance.

Section 2.
